2017 Tri Valley SC Financial Aid Guidelines

The Tri Valley SC has set aside a limited amount of funds to assist member families who are experiencing financial difficulties as a result of economic hardship, loss of income and or family related issues such as separation, death and or catastrophic events, which prohibit families from fulfilling their financial obligation to the Tri Valley Soccer Club. Listed below is the protocol and criteria for financial aid for the 2017 Tri Valley Soccer Club. **ALL FAMILIES MUST REGISTER ONLINE AND PAY THE CLUB REGISTRATION, THE REFUNDABLE VOLUNTEER FEE AND THE FIRST OF THREE PAYMENTS IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR FINANCIAL AID.**

Policy:

1. All families are required to request aid using the TVSC Financial Aid Application in writing, with a detailed explanation of the hardships they are experiencing. This request must be submitted to the BOD of TVSC.
2. Families with multiple children registered with TVSC **can only request assistance/aid for one child.**
3. All families receiving aid are required to sign a letter of agreement which outlines the terms and conditions of the aid package.
4. Notification of awards will be provided within two weeks of the application deadline.
5. Financial aid will be provided in the form of a fee credit against the Club fees.
6. Credit will only be provided for participation fees **excluding registration, 1st payment, uniforms, volunteer fee and team related fees and expenses.**
7. Terms and conditions of approved financial aid will be disclosed and determined individually with each respective applicant.

Criteria:

1. Family must be in good standing with TVSC.
2. Player must be deemed to be in good standing by the head coach and consistently demonstrates commitment and dedication to the team.

3. Family must be willing to do additional volunteer work for the Club in an hourly amount TBD. The Club will identify and provide opportunities to families receiving financial aid so that they will have the opportunity to cover their aid award.
4. Family must agree to pay all costs related to team fees, travel, uniforms and out of pocket expenses incurred by the team, as needed, and at the scheduled times of request.
5. All terms and conditions of the award are to remain confidential – if confidentiality is compromised; the award is subject to forfeiture.
6. If the financial aid recipient is NOT in good standing with their financial obligation to the Club or their team, as of August 15, 2017, the player pass may be revoked and the player will not be allowed to participate in any TVSC training, games and or special events. In addition, the player in default will not be allowed to guest play for any other Club, team or tournament, until the financial commitment is met.
7. Any past due accounts, either to the Club or the team, must be current before any scholarship is considered.
8. Applicants who falsify information will be ineligible for scholarship assistance.
9. Applicants must attend training on a regular basis.

Timeline:

1. Deadline for financial aid applications is March 1, 2017 for all U8 through U14 age group players.
2. Deadline for financial aid applications is June 1, 2017 for all U15 through U18 age group players
